Honduras Feeding Center

Would you believe we are now preparing to build our very first feeding center?

With your help we began feeding children in Cantaranas, Honduras just last year. We rented a house and filled it each day at lunch, and then as more of you began to sponsor children we filled it for two shifts and now for three. We are literally cramming in over 200 children each day and it is becoming an impossible task. There is just not enough room.

My plan was to eventually buy property and build a center that would be able to hold up to 300 kids at a time and have room in it for the storage, the kitchen and a small clinic; as well as a shaded playground area for the children to have a safe place to play. (I don't know of a single playground in the entire country other than at McDonalds). I had no idea that the blessings of the Lord would be so great that we would have to do this in our first year!

As we looked for such a place, we were able to find only one suitable piece of land inside the little town and it is only about two blocks away from our current rented facility. The cost for the 5000 square yards was \$52,000. This past March, Pastor Jim Nagey of the First Missionary Baptist Church in Gilbert, WV came to visit us with three of his church members. (They are currently supporting more than 50 children and wanted to do something big to help us — as if they had not already done enough!) Would you believe me if I told you they have given us a check for \$52,000 to purchase the land? Well, they did! It's a beautiful property with huge mango trees and even some cashew trees. All they ask is that we try to get others to help with the construction costs so they don't have to bear the burden alone.

God has miraculously given us a property big enough for the playground, feeding center and eventually an expanded clinic, a 15 room guest center for those of you who come down on Visionary Trips and even space to have a grade school and Bible College. (see our phase chart on the next page).

As I said, the land is bought and paid for. Now we need to build the center as quickly as possible. We have an estimated cost of only \$25,000 to build the 300 seat cafeteria with a kitchen, small clinic, storage and platform area for use during the daily Bible stories and for evangelistic services. To do this, I need your help and I know many of you will be glad to give it. Some have already pledged to help and nearly \$1000 has already arrived.

If you could give just \$100 for each child you support, that would pay for it. Can you imagine how easy this should be? I know some of you cannot give that much but others could give extra to fill your deficit. Of course, whatever you give is tax deductible and it is a gift that will last beyond your lifetime and mine. Over the decades to come, tens of thousands will be fed and come to Christ in this center. Please help us with a generous gift if you can, as quickly as you can. What's next?

Our next feeding center will begin Lord willing, in August. It is in a little church at the top of a mountain that is only accessible by horses. There are only about 50 children living there so we should not have a need to build a feeding center for them, but if we do, it will be very, very small and house only the center and a clinic.

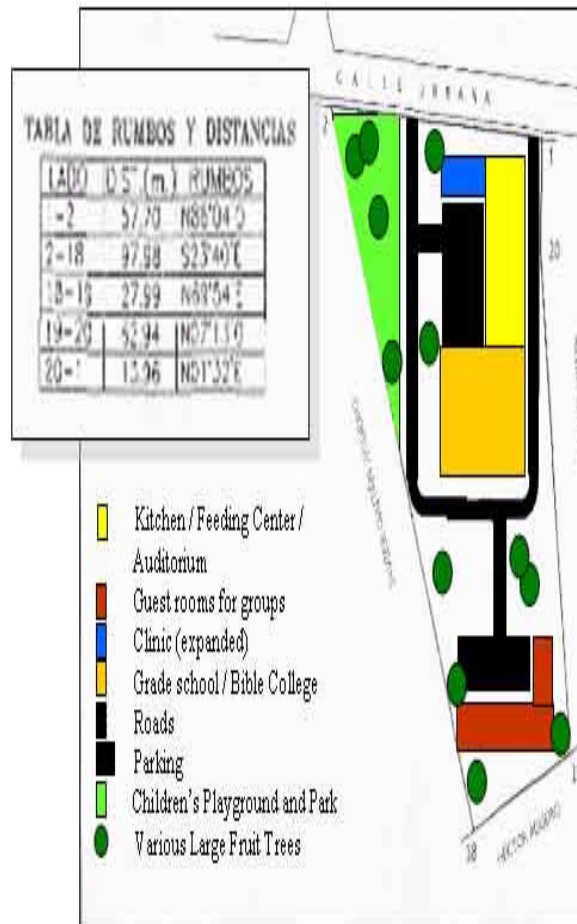
If you can come along from November 9-16 on our next Visionary trip with me,

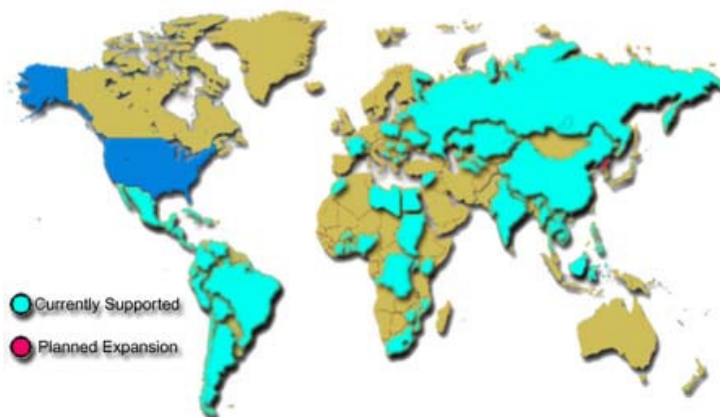

For over a year, I have been working with several Christian organizations and non-profits in order to network and to develop relationships. This is another ministry that I want to focus on them and their impact around the world. I currently have been working with the Final Frontiers Foundation at link <http://www.finalfrontiers.org/>. The Final Frontiers Foundation, Inc., whose effective purpose is to take the Gospel to the more than 3 billion souls who have never before heard the message of the Good News! Currently they are ministering in more than seventy-three countries on five continents. These are countries and peoples primarily closed to traditional missionary outreach, but open to them because of our unique method of missions. Since 1986 Final Frontiers has led the way in the support of national preachers who are starting new churches in areas that are primarily closed to foreign missionaries. Believing that they can more effectively reach their own people for Christ, we began to support them in doing so for around \$1 a day (go to www.finalfrontiers.org for more information). These men have now started more than 24,000 new churches that upon conception, average about 30 new converts each.



They believe that the training and subsidizing of national preachers is the most efficient and effective method of global evangelism. Thus, they seek to raise prayer and financial support from believers in America, for God's servants abroad, who are actively involved in church planning and discipleship. All those subsidized thru this foundation are involved in church planting. Their various outreach ministries include Bible translation, radio broadcasting, camps, Bible schools, outdoor and film evangelism, educational and health programs, blind and leper ministries, orphan centers and refugee ministries. Last January, I had the privilege to have traveled with the founder of Final Frontiers Foundation Jon Nelms and his son Daniel to the Dominican Republic. We planned to visit Haiti, but because of instability were not able to make that trip to visit churches in that region. We did however visit several churches in the Dominican Republic and did a very successful outreach event. We had over six hundred first time visitors to this local church by giving hotdogs to first time visitors. We cooked and served them in about two hours and preached the Gospel message to them.

Reaching the lost: It's like sharing a ...

Ticket to Heaven

Gary Rich is living a dream. While many Christians simply imagine the day they finally lead a friend or acquaintance to Christ, Gary is doing it almost daily. The Tomoka Christian member spearheads a one-man ministry spreading God's news of salvation right on the sands of Volusia County's beaches.

"I just have a passion to do evangelism. I asked God how I could reach hundreds of people in a day, and that's how it began," said Gary.

Before each outreach session, Gary photocopies a batch of simple, lime green tracts, which feature the words "Ticket to Heaven" emblazoned across the top, followed by a few paragraphs of information on the love of God and how to pray for salvation. Then, with his pants pockets filled with the missives, he heads toward the shore. He simply smiles and says hello, hands one to each beachgoer he runs across, and asks, "Did you get a Daytona Heaven ticket?" He doesn't wait for an answer.

The uninitiated may expect the odds of rejection to be high in a ministry such as Gary's. But he has found just the opposite is true.

Because the beachgoers are enjoying a day of relaxation, they are very open to a visit from Gary, who is tall and flashes a warm smile. While a few of those he approaches decline his offer politely, the vast majority will accept Gary's tract, smile and thank him. But what gets Gary excited is the estimated 10 percent who ask him questions, who want to go a step further. Many ask him to pray with them, right on the spot, to accept Christ.

"With many people, their faces light up and they say, 'I really

need this,' or 'I've wanted to know this for years,'" Gary explained. It's this reaction that has him hooked.

"Once you hand one tract to one person, or pray with one person, it's an addiction. I can't stop. I see how easy it is," Gary said. "I can walk a beach, and in two minutes I can win people to Heaven."

Because many of these newest recruits for Christ are tourists, Gary encourages them to find a church home. Sometimes he exchanges phone numbers with them and follows up. A few are locals, and he shares information about Tomoka Christian Church with them. But most of the time, he trusts that God has allowed him to plant a seed that others will water and nurture.

Gary works as a pool maintenance technician at a beachside hotel. So it was natural that his ministry field would be just steps away from his workplace.

The beach evangelist explained that he began his outreach on the beach following a series of messages last year by Joe Puttling, pastor of TCC, encouraging the congregation to get outside their comfort zones and win people for Christ.

"Joe lit a fire under me. Every Sunday he talked about going out and doing something for the lost," Gary explained. "He was a big inspiration."

Joe sees Gary's ministry as a model for others.

"Gary is a great example of why I love to preach here at Tomoka. He listened to God's Spirit and went to work. He is an example for all of us to follow in obedience to our Savior."

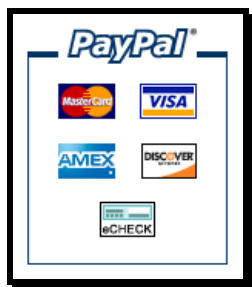
